1. Title: The Hunger Project

Feeding the hungry and paying the school fees in two rural communities in Kwahu Afram Plains South District in the Eastern Region and the Valley Zone Sub-district in the Upper East region for two(2) years

2 Title: My Girlfriend, Her Welfare

Provision of sanitary pads for school children who cannot afford pads but use rags during their menstruation. This situation causes diseases. Duration is of two(2) years

3. Title: Climate Change Adaptation

Bee Keeping, mushrooms, snail, fish farming and growing of extinct and teak trees for two(2) years in two(2) districts

4.Title: Climate Change Adaptation

Planting of draught resistant trees, provision of solar irrigation for green house organic farming, provision of solar light for off-grid communities of five(5) districts in four(4) regions of Ghana
