WCS Services Towards Rural Women Empowerment by Creating CFC's

In Karnataka most of the rural women folks are engaged in agricultural activities either as daily wage earners or small land holders. The women who are not going to work, are predominantly engaged as just housewives looking after the houses and kids

Many enterprising women have taken up the memberships in SHGs and are very active there. But unfortunately most of these SHGs are engaged in micro finance activities, as it is very lucrative and need of the hour.

They are most potential candidates for undertaking MSME activities within their villages or taluka places

In this direction WCS and VKF have envisaged an ambitious project of linking these SHG members to the Common Facility Centers – CFC, which intern pave the way towards the MSME culture.

The Model:

All the SHG Women members are the stakeholders for the project

The SPV will be implementing the entire project under the guidance of WCS and VKF WCS and VKF will provide complete handholding in setting up of the Common Facility Centre

Govt. will facilitate the funding for these CFCs to the Rural women, under its various Women Empowerment programs and schemes

SPV will provide the leased land for setting up of the Common Facility Centre for the project

Each of the beneficiaries can utilise the services made available in the CFC and enhance their product value to a greater height.
